Partner Visa Interview Questions



The Australian Department of Immigration may conduct an interview either in person or by phone, for visa applicants and sponsors, when applied for a partner visa application. The department holds the right to probe each person's knowledge about the relationship and of their partner, to determine whether a relationship is genuine.

The following is just a sample list of some potential questions that might be asked in an interview but not limited to it. Please keep in mind that this list is only a sample based on our experience with partner visa applications and interviews, and the Australian Department of Immigration reserves the right to ask any appropriate question. If you believe a question is inappropriate, especially if it involves intimate details of your relationship, you have the right to object and tell the interviewer, politely, that you believe that question is inappropriate.

History of Your Relationship

1. How did you meet (mention source - through a friend or social media etc.)?
2. When did you meet (DATE)?
3. Where did you meet (place)?
4. What did you find attractive about your partner at first?
5. What do you (now) find attractive about your partner?
6. When did you start your relationship together (date is important)?
7. When did you fall in love with your partner (similar to Q. 6)?

About Your Engagement and/or Marriage

(NOTE: Dates and approximate numbers are important)

1. When did you decide to get married?
2. When did you officially become engaged?
3. Where were you when you became engaged?
4. Why are you getting married?
5. Where was the marriage?
6. What was the name of the religious place (church/temple) you were married at?
7. How many people attended your marriage ceremony and reception?
8. What restaurant did you use for the food for your marriage?
9. Which of your family attended the marriage ceremony?
10. Which of your partner's family attended the marriage ceremony?
11. Before you were married, how long did you date for?

About Your Defacto Relationship

1. How long have you and your partner been in a relationship?
2. How long have you and your partner been living together?
3. Have you and your partner lived apart during the last 12 months? If so, please provide details.
4. What addresses have you and your partner lived at together, and for how long?
5. When and why did your previous de facto relationship end? (If applicable)
